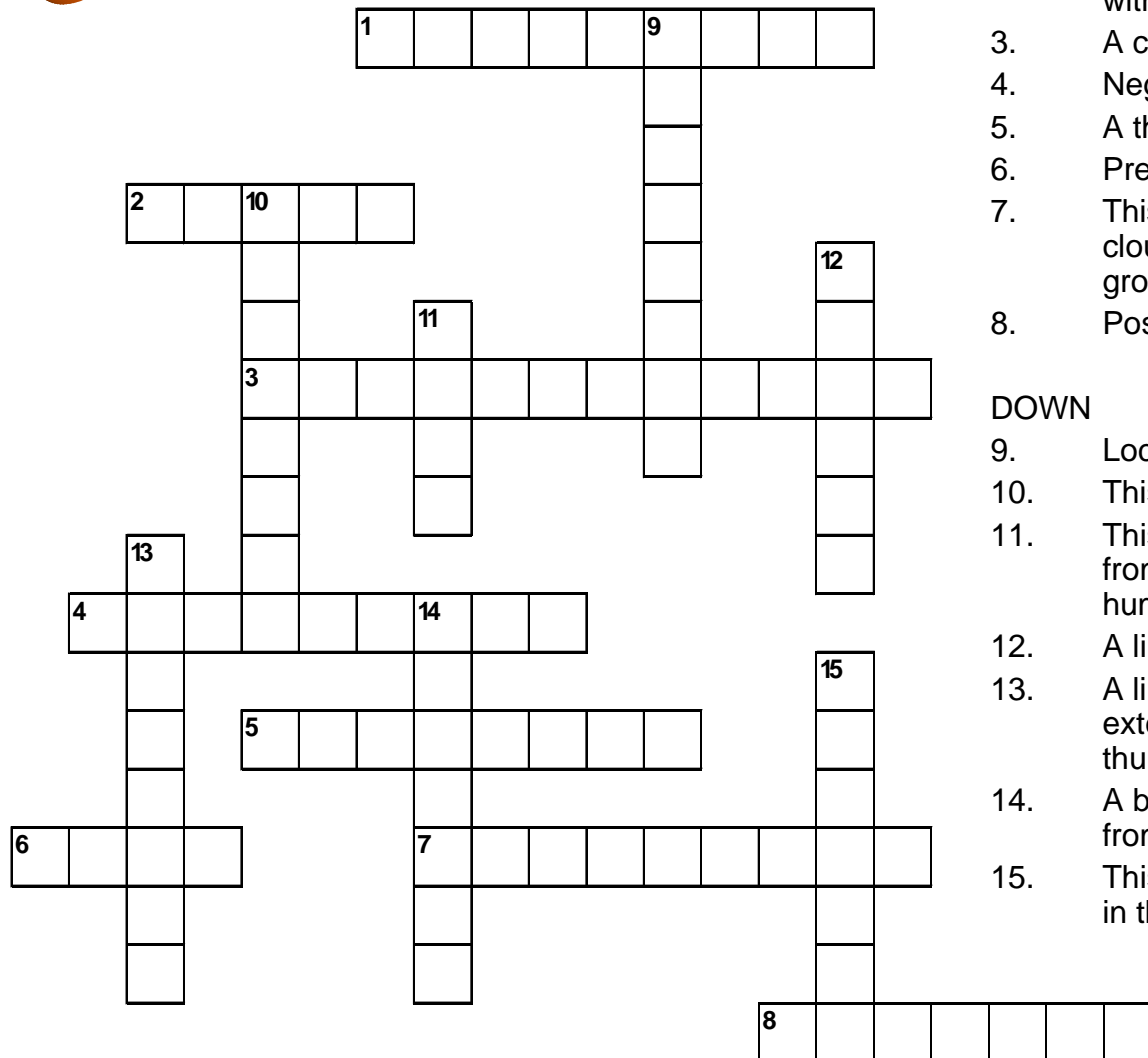


Cross Word



ACROSS

1. A violent thunderstorm containing updrafts and downdrafts that allow the storm to maintain itself for several hours
2. A low, wedge-shaped cloud that is associated with a thunderstorm gust front
3. A cloud type that is dense and develops vertically
4. Negatively-charged particles
5. A thunderstorm that divides into two storms
6. Precipitation in the form of ice
7. This happens when negative charges in the cloud are attracted to positive charges in the ground
8. Positively-charged particles

DOWN

9. Location of the center of the storm
10. This kind of discharge is a sudden flow of current
11. This front forms a boundary between cold air from the thunderstorm downdraft and warm, humid surface air
12. A line of active thunderstorms
13. A line of cumulus clouds connected to and extending outward from the most active part of a thunderstorm
14. A boundary separating thunderstorm-cooled air from the surrounding air
15. This is caused by a sudden expansion of the air in the path of the electrical discharge
